ITEM 2 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

23 17-18 It was **RESOLVED** that the Minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council held on 8th August 2017 be accepted as a true record.

ITEM 3 MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

8th August 2017

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156 8.8.17 Mr. Peaker: Copy letter to EHDC re Froyle Park re Froyle Green naming 158 8.8.17 EHDC S. Brackley: Copy reply to M. Peaker re Froyle Green naming

161 10.8.17 EHDC L. Wells: Froyle House reply: Froyle House, alteration to a listed wall, enforcement notice passed EHDC Solicitor to issue. Notice should stipulate: 1 Repair the listed wall using materials, mortar and capping to match existing.

176 30.8.17 EHDC L. Wells: Froyle House: If appeal 6 months before decision. If appeal dismissed will be compliance period perhaps to spring/early summer 2018.

Mrs. Southern reported recent communication from Planning Compliance and Trees Manager, East Hampshire District Council, that notice has been served on all interested parties. It was noted that the notice had been issued under S215 (untidy site) not Listed Buildings, so that if there were an appeal against the notice it would be heard in the Magistrates Court.

5.1 Hut replacement/Playground

It was reported that there were no quotations for the <u>hut replacement</u>. It was agreed that <u>Mr. Macnabb</u> <u>and Mr. Whines</u> would ask a building surveyor to assess whether the hut should be refurbished, altered, or demolished, and the cost effectiveness of any work.

Mr. Macnabb to compile invoices for hut/playground project to be copied to EHDC against £29000 S106 money to be recovered and £15000 grant received.

Playground sign to be received when final report sent to EHDC.

5.2 Froyle Park

179 30.8.17 Mrs. Southern: Mr. Roach: reviewed <u>Gid Lane</u> plan. Acceleration\deceleration lane should be considered.

<u>Mr. Deans</u> to ask Mr. Warren of NJG whether a plan for the junction had been sent to Hampshire Highways. It was suggested that the County Councillor could be consulted.

<u>Wedding venue</u>: Further disturbances had been reported by residents. It was considered that inadequate staffing could affect licence requirements. Signs to direct visitors to the venue had been prepared by NJG.

Options of putting a smaller bin on a pole near the wall or another bin at the corner near the Barracks/West End Farm, or both.

216 28.9.17 Mr. Deans Signing, from Traffic Management Engineer, EHDC:

'Unsuitable for HGVs' not applicable for Froyle. EHDC suggests signing for HGVs at Golden Pot to A31 via Alton, and 'No footway' signs to be erected at each end of Lower Froyle on the Froyle Road. HCC had a policy to reduce sign clutter, but only through a Community Funded Scheme - i.e. we would have to pay. It was noted that there were still redundant 'Disabled Children' signs **Mr Deans** to see if they could be removed at no cost.

<u>Mr. Deans</u> to write to Linden Homes to ask that they review their signs on the Hen & Chicken Hill as the construction phase on the new estate has finished.

It was considered that the exit at <u>Gate A from the Linden Homes</u> estate onto the Hen & Chicken Hill did not give enough warning of that junction. . **Mr Deans** to review plans for junction and advise accordingly.

The planned permissive <u>footpath</u> inside the field parallel to Hen & Chicken Hill and the option of a footpath between the wall and the road were discussed.

- **9.2** Mr. Whines: <u>Froyle Park</u>, letter to Mr. N. Leach ref. 13 17-18 dated 31st August 2017. 9.2 Failing an adequate response from EHDC a stage 2 complaint will be reconsidered, and it was agreed that <u>Mr. Whines</u> and <u>Dr. Roberts</u> should draft a letter to Mr. A. Ezekiel and the new EHDC Leader for a response. <u>Dr. Roberts</u> to ask C. Haveron to put a question on the existence of any report by EHDC officers on Froyle Park on the agenda of the next Community Forum. **Mr. Deans** to attend the Community Forum, and **Dr. Roberts** to ask for a report.
- **9.3** Mr. Macnabb: <u>recreation ground mowing</u> contract. <u>Mr. Macnabb</u> to confirm with Mr. Wimshurst that his quotation is still current, and to ask OCS for an estimate of their charges for a contract in 2018. <u>Clerk</u> to ask neighbouring parishes whom they use for gang mowing.
- **9.4** It was reported that the <u>sewerage</u> lorry presence at the Anchor is due to a cracked sewer pipe between the pumping station and Lower Froyle.
- **9.5** Mr. Deans reported that the War Memorials Trust Pre-Application for work on the Froyle **War Memorial** was due by the end of the month. If favourable, a formal application would be made for re-cutting the lettering and improvements to paving around the memorial.
