We the Undersigned Tithe Eommissioners for England and Wales by virtue of the power to that effect given to us by the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales Do hereby assign the Parish of Froyle in the County of Southampton to be a District within which the extraordinary Rent Charge in lieu of Tithes upon Hop Grounds shall be after the rate of Twenty shillings for every imperial acre to be paid according to the provisions of the said Act. In testimony thereof We have hereunto set our Hands and caused our Official Seal to be affixed this twenty fourth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty seven.

**WHEREAS** an Agreement for the Commutation of Tithes in the Parish of Froyle in the County of Southampton was on the third day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty six confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales of which Agreement with the Schedules thereunto annexed the following is a copy.

A Proximal Agreement for the Commutation of the Titus of Parish of Troylein the Camiyof Suthampton purcunt to the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales made and executed at a Parochial Meeting of the Land owners and Tithe owner duly called and holden in the said Parish and adjourned and holden by adjournment on the twelfth day of Tebruary one thousand eight hundred and forty five and since perfected by and between The Reverend Sir Thomas Combe Miller Baronet who in his capacity as Impropriate Rector of the said Parish in entitled to the Tithes of Corn Grain Hay and Wool of the lands hereinafter mentioned to be the property and in the occupation of Henry Wheeler and who is also Patron of the Vicarage of the said Parish of the first part.

**The** several persons whose names are inserted in the second Schedule hereinafter contained and who are the owners of the Tithes of Corn Grain Hay and Wool arising from their respective lands of the second part.

**The** said Sir Thomas Combe Miller who in his other capacity as Vicar of the said Parish is entitled unto all the residue of the Tithes payable within the said Parish of the third part.

And the several persons owners of land within the said Parish by whom or by whose Agents duly authorized in that behalf these Presents are executed and the interest of which Land owners in the lands of the said Parish is not less than two thirds of the lands therein subject to Tithes of the fourth part.

Whereas the said Sir Thomas Eombe Miller is as such Impropriate Rector the owner of all the Tithes of Corn Grain Hay and Wool arising from certain lands in the said Parish called Little Lees, Great Lees, Hartwells, Water Close, and Row Long Meadow, Snake Meadow, Mill Meadow, Hill Close, Hill Close Hanger, Mill Meadow Hanger, Grass Close and Newlands containing together by estimation forty four acres one rood and thirty four perches belonging to and now in the occupation of Henry Wheeler which lands are well known by metes and bounds.

And whereus the several persons whose names are set out in the second Schedule hereunder written are respectively the owners of the Tithes of Corn Grain Hay and Wool, arising from the lands set opposite to their respective names and described in the said Schedule and they have full power and authority to merge the said Tithes and are desirious that the same should be merged in the said lands.

**They do hereby** so far as relates to their respective lands by virtue of the powers for that purpose contained in the acts for the commutation of Tithes, declare that the said tithes shall henceforth be merged and extinguished in the freehold and inheritance of the said several lands.

It is hereby agreed that the annual sum of six pounds by way of rent charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the said Sir Thomas Combe Miller his heirs and assigns instead of all the Tithes of Corn Grain Hay and Wool arising from the said forty four acres one rood and thirty four perches of land as hereinbefore mentioned.

And it is further agreed that the annual sum of one hundred and ninety pounds by way of ordinary rent charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the said Sir Thomas Combe Miller as Vicar of the said Parish and to his Successors instead of all the Vicarial Tithes of the lands of the said Parish other than tithe of Hops and instead of all moduses and compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable to him as such Vicar and to his Successors of all the lands of the said Parish or the produce thereof A summary description of which lands is contained in the Schedule hereunder written or hereunto annexed.

It is hereby further agreed that an extraordinary charge of one pound per imperial acre and a proportionate sum for any quantity of land less than an acre shall be payable in respect of all the lands in the said Parish which are now or may hereafter be cultivated as Hop Grounds and that if any such lands shall hereafter cease to be cultivated as Hop Grounds and shall be restored to an ordinary course of Husbandry they shall then cease to pay such extraordinary charge.

And it is hereby further agreed that the lands included in this Agreement shall be discharged from the payment of tithes except as excepted in the said Act from the first day of October preceding the Confirmation of the Apportionment of the rent charges hereinbefore agreed on and that the first payment of such rent charges shall be made or recoverable on the expiration of six calendar months from the time from which the said lands are discharged from the payment of Tithes.

In Witness whereof the said parties to this Agreement or their Agents duly authorized in their names and on their behalf have hereunto subscribed and set their respective hands and seals.

**The** whole Parish of Froyle contains by estimation three thousand six acres of land statue measure, the whole of which is subject to tithes.

The whole quantity of land subject to tithes in the said Parish which is cultivated as arable land is by estimation two thousand eight hundred and twenty acres statue measure.

The whole quantity of land subject to tithes within the said Parish cultivated as meadow or pasture land is by estimation three hundred and eighty two acres statue measure.

**The** whole quantity of land subject to tithes within the said Parish now cultivated as Wood and Coppice Ground is by estimation three hundred and ninety eight acres statue measure.

The Glebe land of the said Parish which if not in the hands of the owner or owners would be subject to tithes amounts by estimation to about half an acre statue measured.
